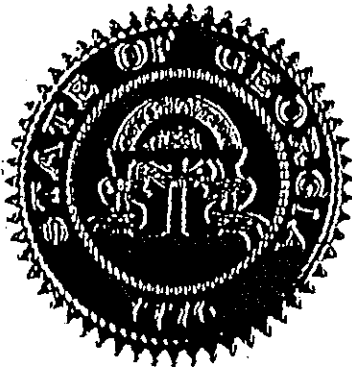

To amend an Act creating the Etowah Water and Sewer Authority, approved March 18, 1980 (Ga. L. 1980, p. 3407), as amended, so as to change the provisions relating to the issuance of revenue bonds by the Authority; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

Section 1. An Act creating the Etowah Water and Sewer Authority, approved March 18, 1980 (Ga. L. 1980, p. 3407), as amended, is amended by striking in its entirety Section 5 and inserting in its place a new Section 5 to read as follows:

"Section 5. Revenue Bonds. The Authority, or any authority or body which has or which may in the future succeed to the powers, duties and liabilities vested in the Authority shall have power and is authorized at one time, or from time to time, to provide by resolution for the issuance of revenue bonds, in a sum not to exceed six million (\$6,000,000.00) dollars outstanding at any one time, for the purpose of paying all or any part of the cost as defined in this section of any one or more projects. The principal and interest of such revenue bonds shall be payable solely from the special fund provided in this section for such payment. The bonds of each issue shall be dated, shall bear interest at the rate or rates and shall mature at such time or times as permitted by resolution of the Authority. The bonds shall be payable in such medium of payment as to both

The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to the initial members of the Authority appointed under the provisions of this section."

"(f) Should the initial term of any member of the Authority expire before there are any users of the facilities, the remaining members of the Authority shall elect, by majority vote, a person who is otherwise duly qualified as a member of the Authority to serve until the first annual meeting of the users. In the event of
